



Groups

- Groups have a strong and permanent identity, formed around the group leader
- Researchers identify themselves both to groups and HIIT research programmes
- Another dimension in the organizational matrix
- Every group should belong primarily to one research program
- Transparent rules on how infrastructure funding can be used for the needs of each research group
- Programmes should not increase internal bureaucracy (!)
 - project funding -> Project Manager
 - infra funding -> Research Programme Director

Research Challenge (1/4)

Mobile and ubiquitous interaction

- Mobile cognition
- Emotional adaptation
- Field trials in real settings enable to investigate thoroughly the implications and value of technological interventions.

Research Challenge (2/4)

Open media creation, management, distribution and metadata

 We build technical platforms and tools that support open media creation and distribution, foster new types of computer-mediated collaboration and learning, and help the development of related business activities.

Research Challenge (3/4)

Understanding dynamic social behaviour

 Based on collected datasets on computer-mediated social activities, we, in collaboration with other HIIT research programmes, develop tools and methods to model such dynamic social networks. We seek to combine these with novel methods for communityand group-centric product and service design.
