## Sample Legal Challenges

## Privacy

- Data protection law will be outdated
- Current classification (sensitive data, private data, and other data) needs to be enhanced
- Other forms of privacy increasingly important
- Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)
  - FI: from node-centricity to information-centricity
    - Copying is mandatory no longer legally interesting
    - Access to information and modifying it will be essential
- Contracts and Consumer Protection
  - Liabilities and consumer issues in publish-subscribe model

## **Studying Future Internet Legals**

- How to solve problems:
  - Contracts increase transaction costs
  - Global laws are unrealistic
  - ⇒ Innovative regulative solutions are required:
    - "soft law", "code as code" supported by the legal system
- Empirical studies needed
  - Traditional legal studies are not enough, since statutes, court cases and other historical documents alone don't help us in the new environment
  - User studies, socio-economic research are required
